**OFFERING ENVELOPES:**

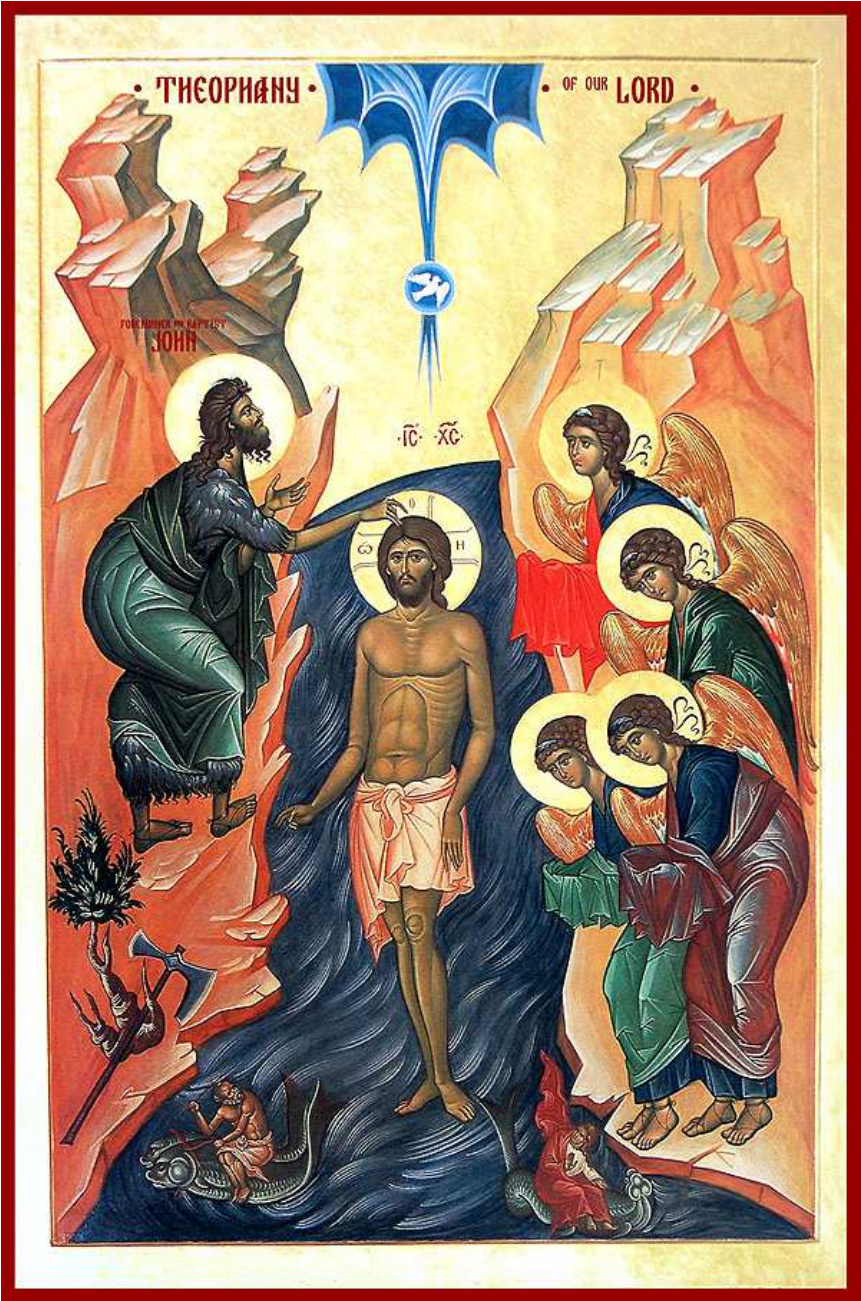
Offering envelopes for 2023 are available in the vestibule. If you do not have a box with your name on it and would like to obtain offering envelopes, please see Father Christopher.
