### RETREAT:

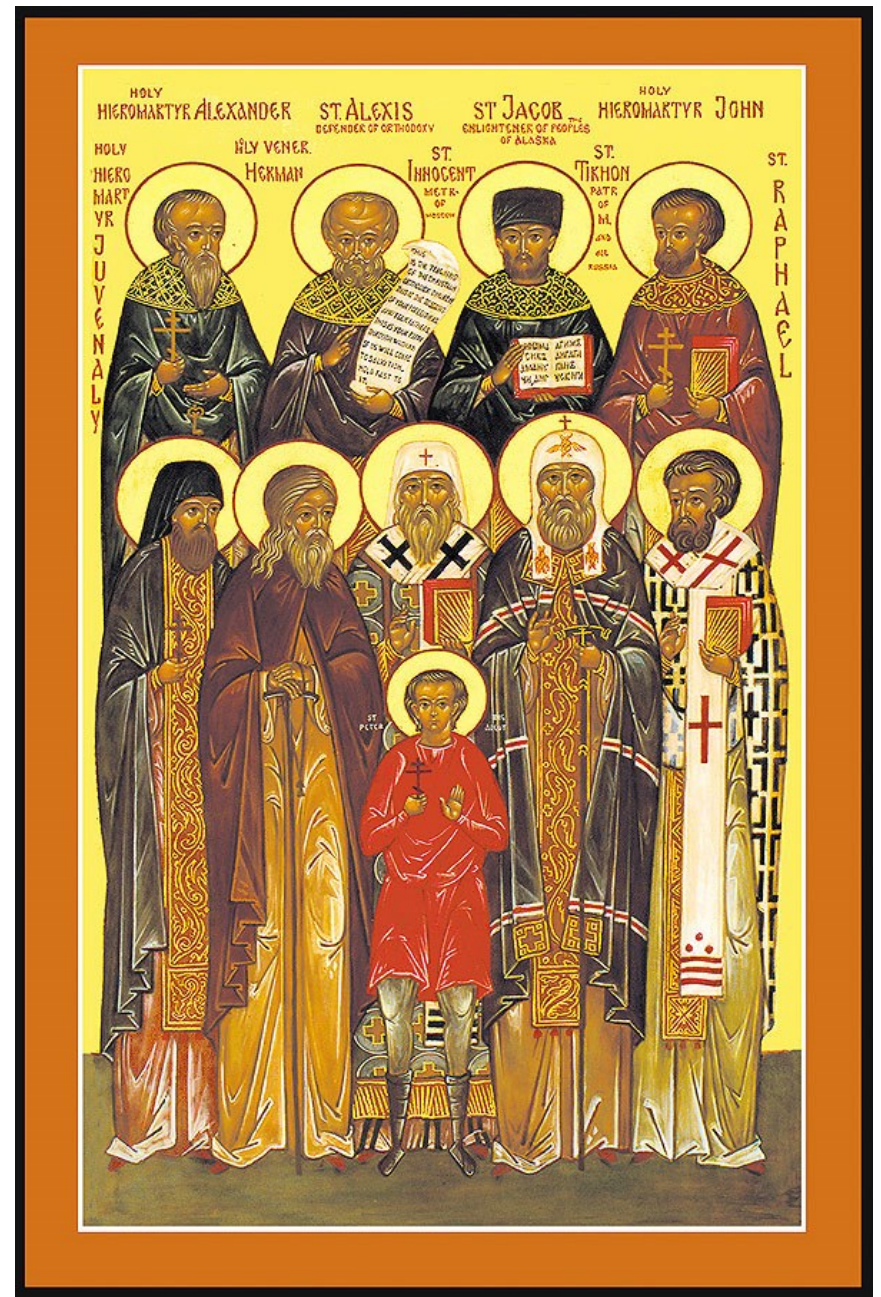
