On Sunday, April 6, at 5:00 p.m., we will have a special Holy Unction service here at Holy Trinity.

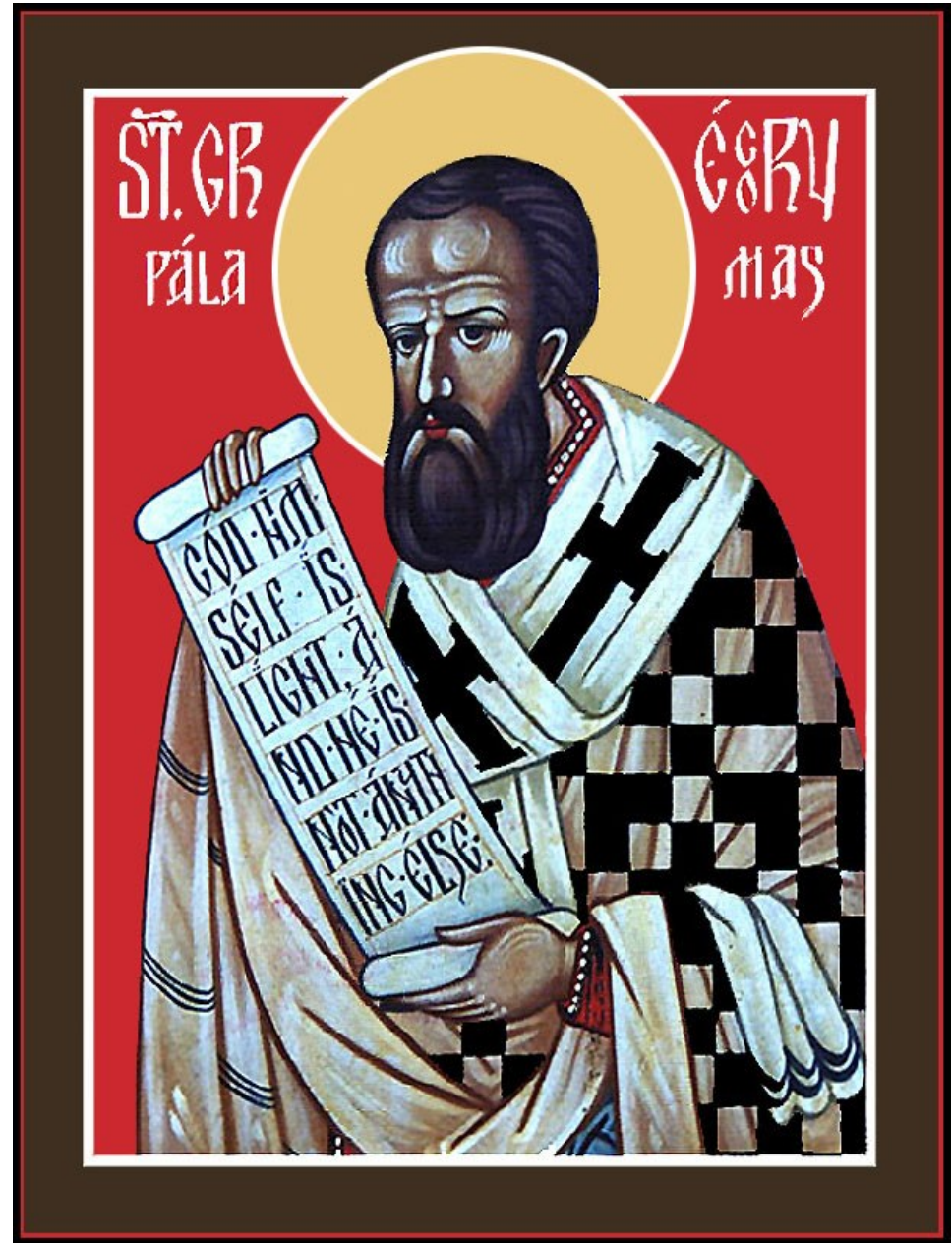
On Monday April 7, at 6:30 p.m., a Deanery Pre-sanctified Liturgy will be hosted by St. Andrew Church in Maple Hts.
