### **YOUNG ADULT FELLOWSHIP:**

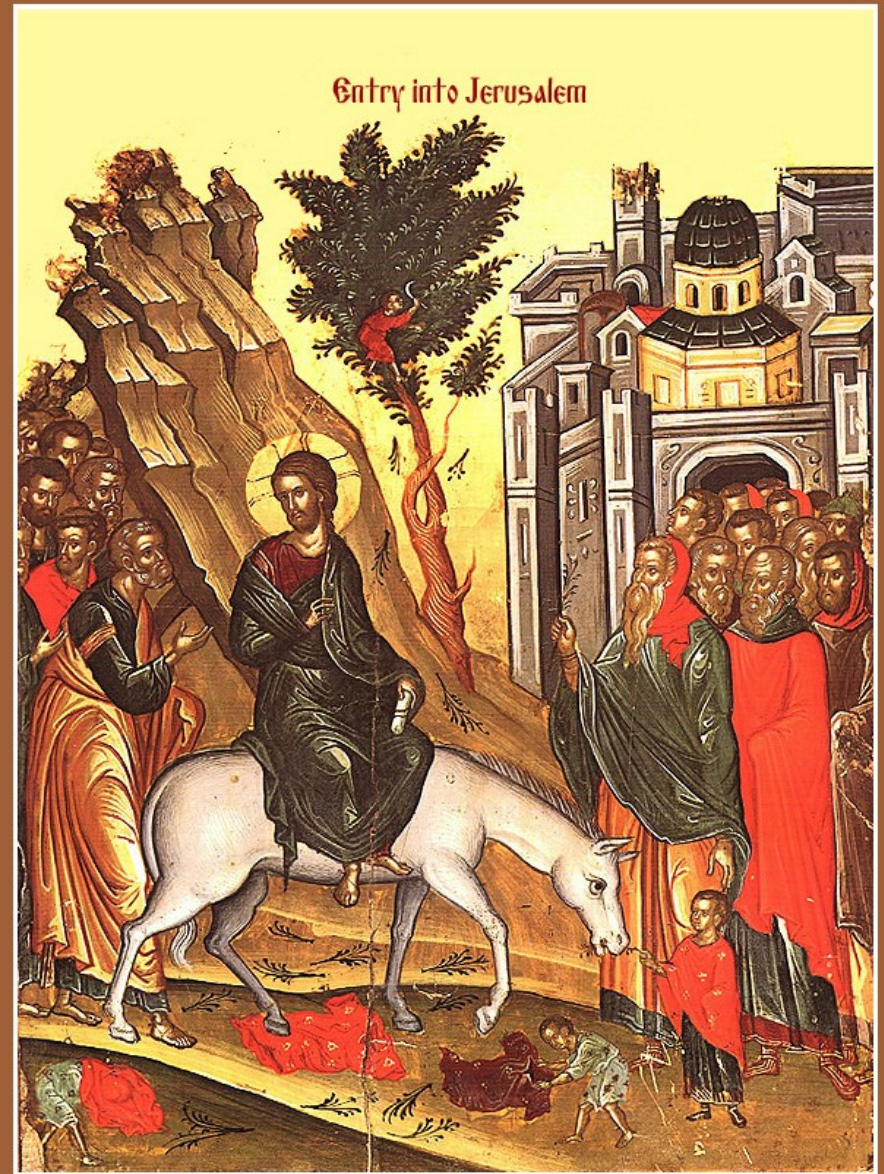
